


The Mark

The Mascot

The lion represents Jesus as our King. In Genesis 49, Judah is described as a lion, and from Judah's line, Jesus, the Savior, would come. This imagery is revisited in Revelation 5, where Jesus is called the "Lion of the tribe of Judah," signifying His heavenly coronation as He as cends to sit on the throne after His work of salvation was completed. As a School and Church, we faithfully, lovingly, and thankfully follow Christ, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, who has battled and conquered for us. And as His people, we live in His strength and victory, boldly and confidently following Him and living out our faith as we love and serve others in His name.
